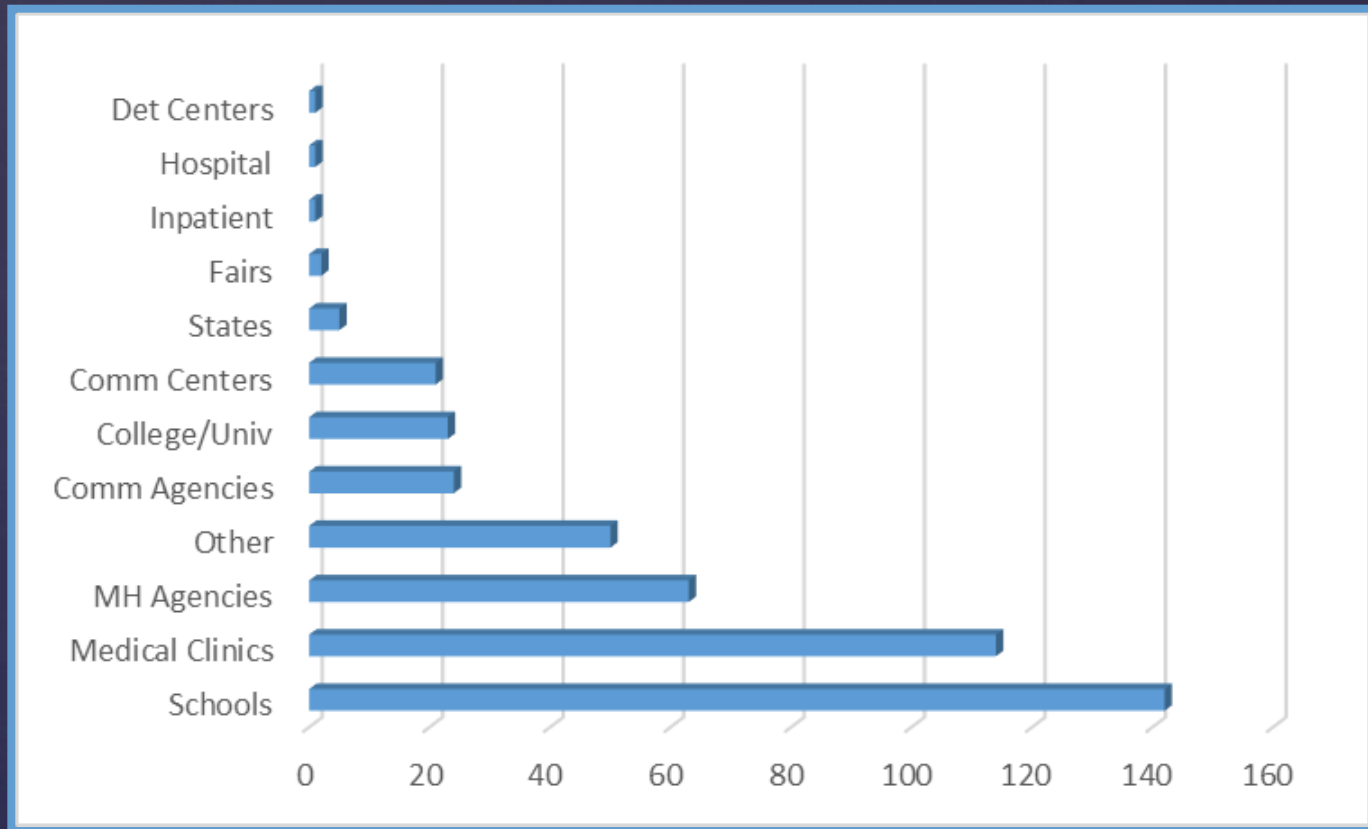

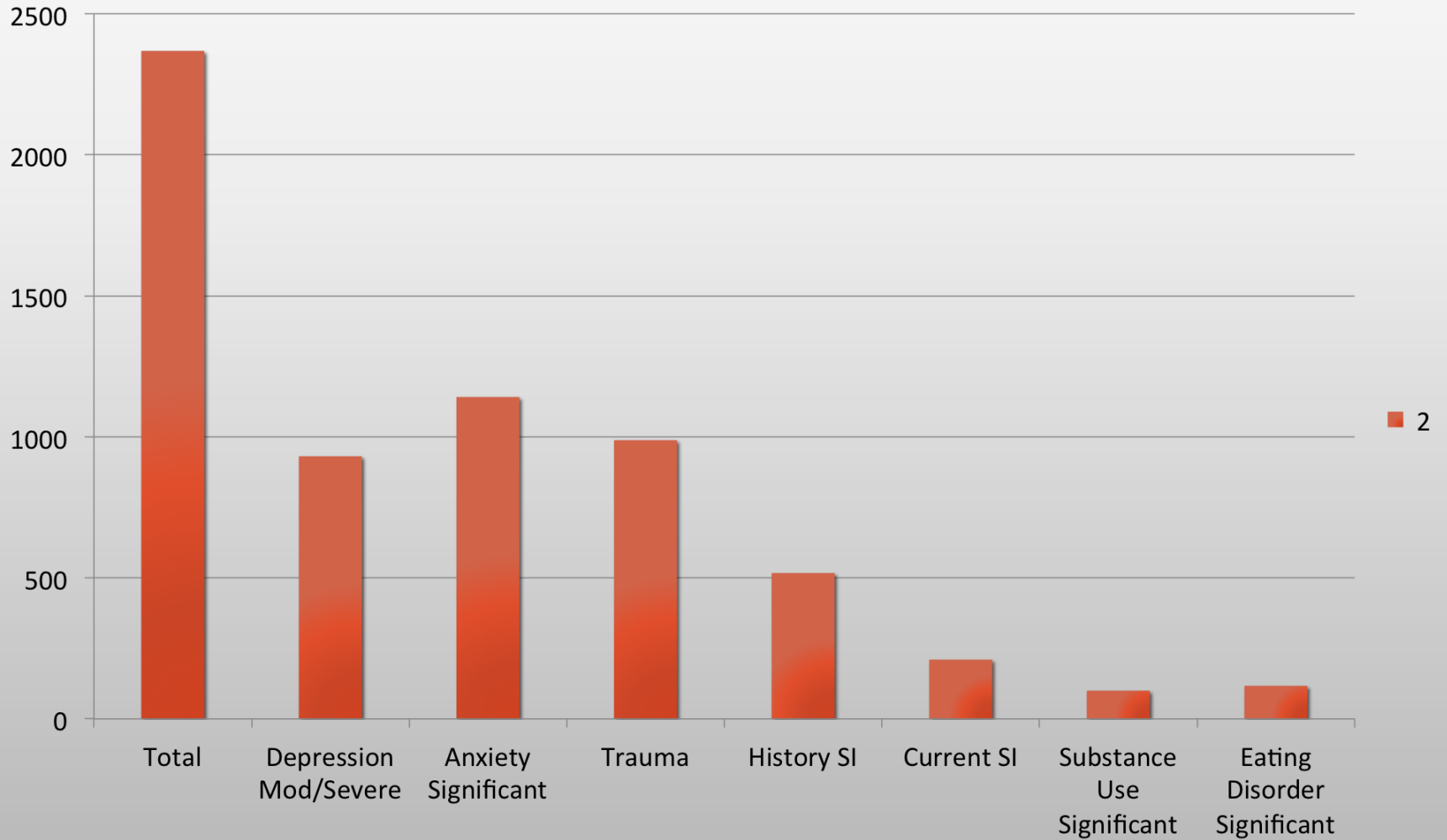

- 1 Emergency Department (readiness phase)

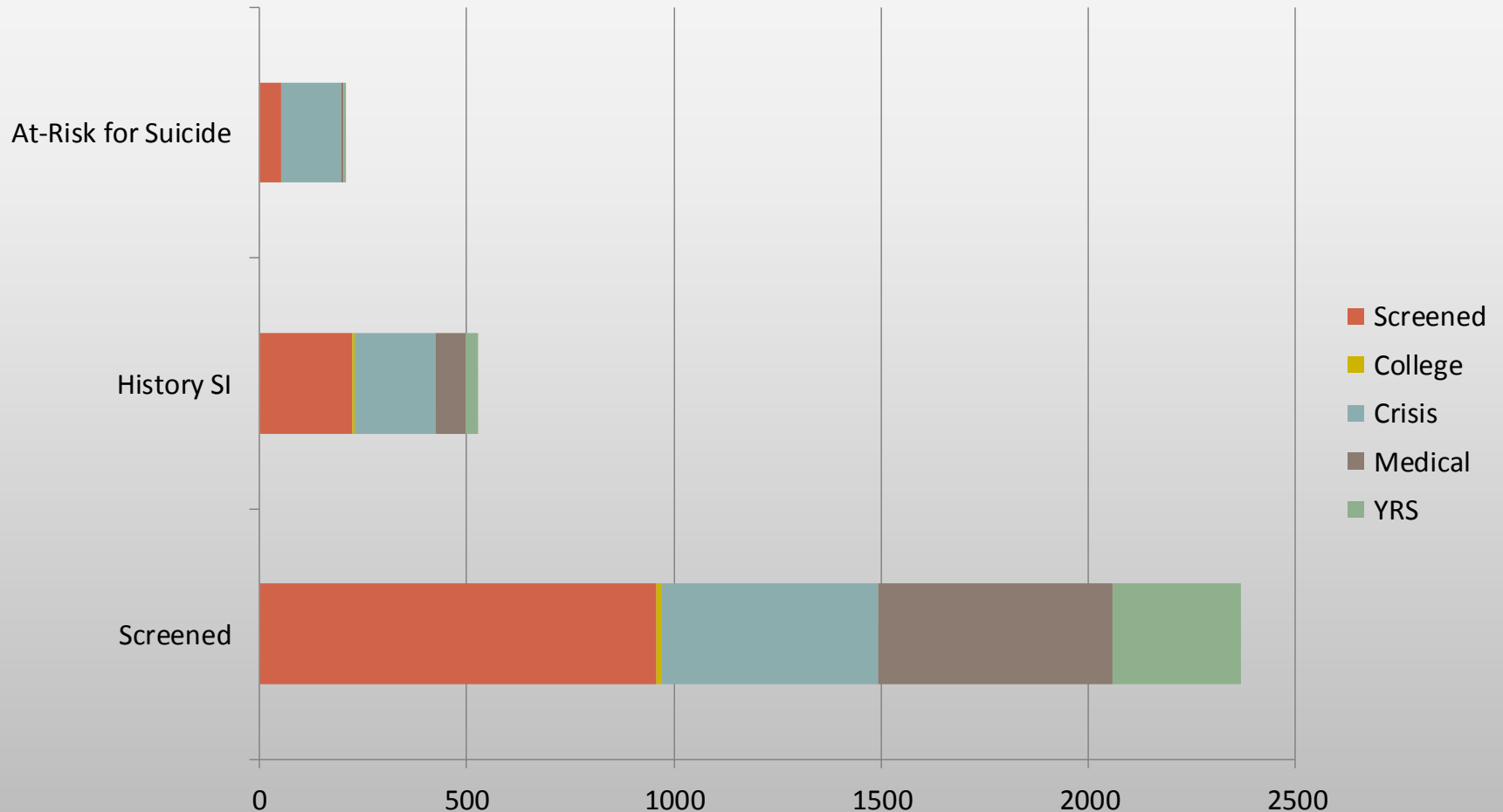
